





The mission of the ECRSSA is to provide support and services to transitioning clients through an intentional network of community and faith-based organizations in partnership with the criminal justice system.




Traditional Model of Providing Services to Transitioning Clients





ECRSSA IMPACT RECIDIVISM




GVRS IMPACT 2017-2019

 70% of individuals who have attended a "call in" had not had ANY new charges following a "call in".

•93% of individuals who have attended a "call in" had not had any new charges for violent offenses or firearms following a "call in".
